Functional Groups

Organic families contain a certain combination of elements called functional groups

Adding a functional group to a hydrocarbon changes its physical and chemical properties in a predictable way.

- 1. Hydroxyl group
- 2. Amine group
- 3. Carbonyl group
- 4. Carboxyl group

Adding the above functional groups result in polar molecules which will create higher melting and boiling points than hydrocarbons.

If they have O-H and N-H bonds, the molecules can hydrogen bond and are even more polar.
